Paisley Wines is created through Derek and Kirsten's love affair with the Barossa.

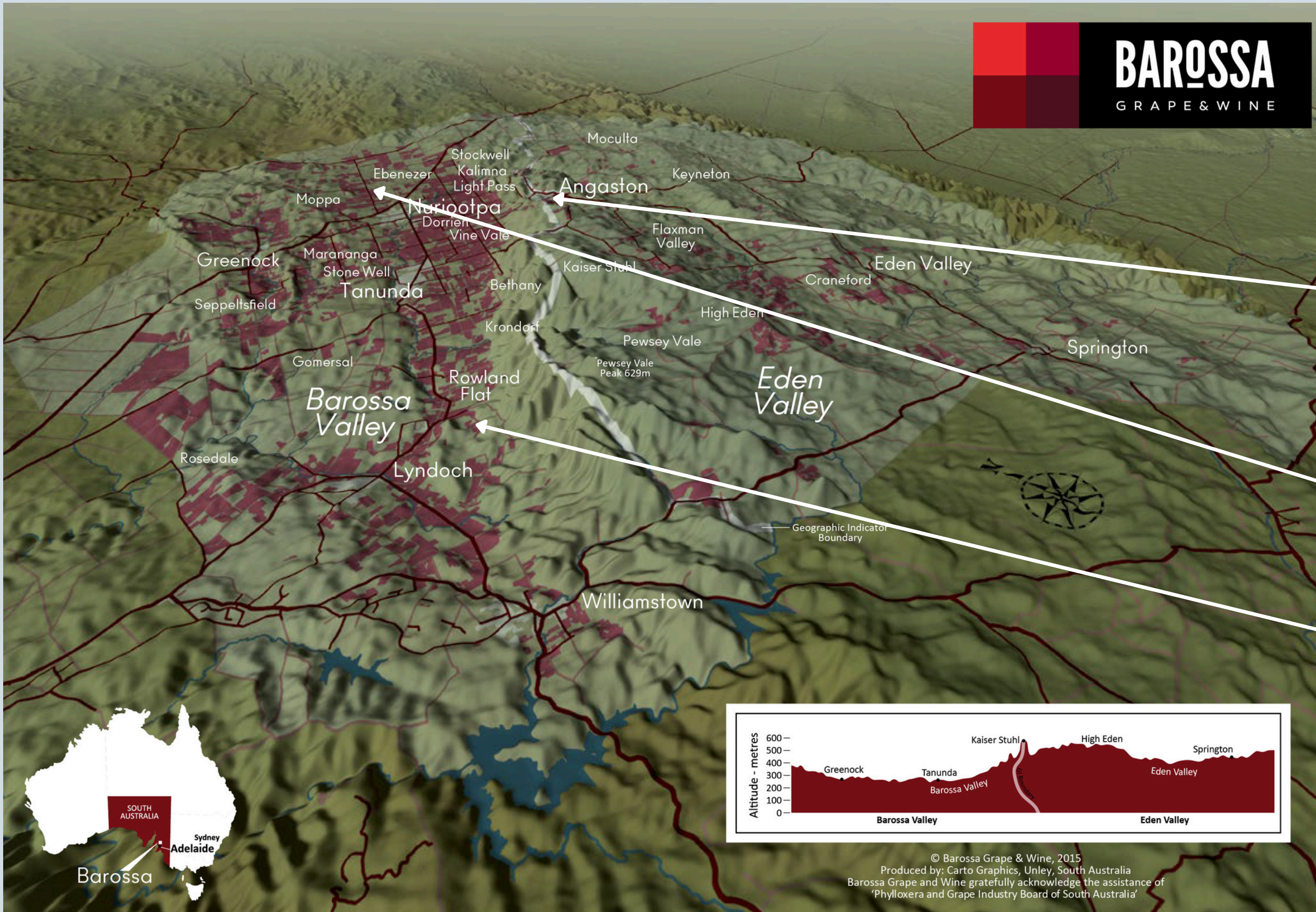

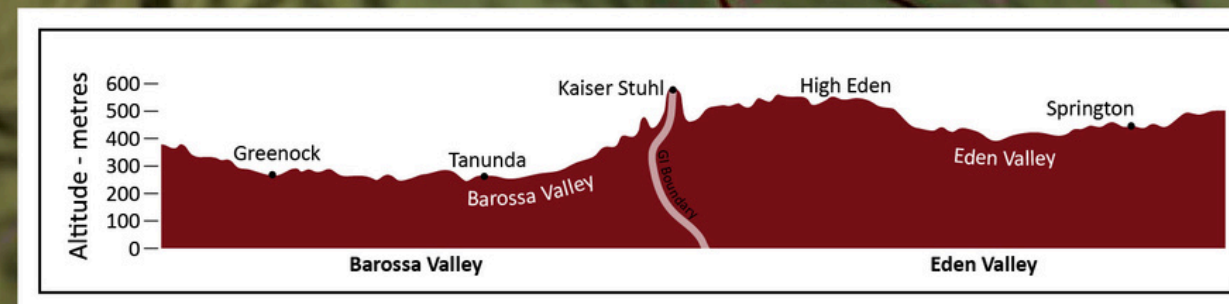

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OUR ESTATE VINEYARD



The Paisley Vineyard sits high above the town of Angaston, on the border between Barossa Valley and Eden Valley.

While at a higher altitude than much of the Barossa Valley floor, the exposed site allows for intense ripening of the Shiraz fruit and produces rich generosity. Complimented with fruit sourced from the warmer Barossa Valley floor, the range offers finesse, bright colours and flavours.

Eden Valley has shallow rocky soils which produce a minerality in the wines, accompanied by herbal savoury notes. The Barossa floor produces wines with bright red fruits, sweetness and depth.

FABRIC

The small town of Paisley was originally a textile town which became renown for producing fabric with the paisley design.

The textiles used and the decorative patterns have influenced both the names of the Fabric range as well as the labels.

These wines are designed to be served with food. They are elegant, have rich flavour with a soft mouthfeel and finish.

Premium French oak is used in the Silk Shiraz whereas old French oak in the Grenache and Mataro.

CELTIC



The influence of the owner's combined Irish and Scottish heritage comes through the Single Vineyard Celtic Series.

The **Maeve Shiraz**, named for an Irish Goddess, comes from premium fruit in Barossa Valley, partnered with quality new oak, offering the depth and richness customers expect from this premium wine region.

The **Maeve Shiraz Cabernet** is a new blend that will be continued into the future. Choosing premium Barossa Valley Shiraz and Cabernet to make an elegant but bold wine.

The **Clurichaun Mataro**, named for the bad tempered cousin to the Leprechaun, is a rich single vineyard wine from the Barossa Valley.

TEXTURE



The Texture series features three distinct Shiraz built on generous fruit, hands on winemaking, expressive soils and quality oak. Amazing fruit from 90-year-old to 22-year-old vines, planted in three of the Barossa's unique Grounds Zones, offered Derek the perfect foundation for the Texture series.

Ebenezer located at the Northern end of the Barossa Valley, altitude of 280m, vine age of 45 years. This vineyard has earthy rich red clay soil with ironstone and quartz.

Angaston in Eden Valley, at a higher altitude of 440m, vine age of 22 years, this amphitheatre style vineyard experiences cooler conditions than the Barossa floor and has fertile, black stony soils, dotted with Angaston Marble, ironstone and quartz.

Lyndoch in the Southern end of the Barossa at the lowest altitude of 230m, vine age of 90+ years, this vineyard has deep red clay over limestone.
